Project Manager Responsibilities – Homer Simpson

- Story Board (See Example)
- Setting Timelines and deadlines
- Organizing meetings
- Taking notes during group meetings

Camera & Graphics Manager Responsibilities – Glenn Quagmire

- Acquiring all necessary equipment to shoot video from MDS (Building 2)
- Creating/Acquiring and managing all graphic assets
- Keeping a detailed shooting log the editor will use during capture
- Responsible for updating group website

Editing Manager - Batman

- Assist Project Manager & Graphics Manager prior to editing
- Review video footage with Camera & Graphics manager
- Select all audio that will be used within project
- Bringing the project storyboard to life in Final Cut Express
- Export and Post video to Vimeo.com
